

Medical Student Residency Applicant Timeline

MS2 YEAR

- Join EM interest group
- Plan MS3 yearly schedule and elective time

MS3 YEAR

January – July

- Join EM interest groups/become active in your EM dept
 - <http://www.acep.org/>
 - <http://saem.org/>
- Plan 1-2 EM elective(s) during MS3 or early MS4
- Identify writers for Letters of Recommendation (3)
 - USMGs – contact your Dean’s Office for their timeline to upload your letters.
 - IMGs- Once ECFMG receives your letters, it can take 1-2 weeks to be uploaded
- Plan MS4 schedule to allow for any remaining EM electives and for interviews during key months

MS4 YEAR

August

- Complete EM elective(s) (if not already completed)
- Solidify writers for Letters of Recommendations
- Organize information for your CV
- Start drafting personal statement

September

- NRMP Registration opens

October

- Interviews

November

- NRMP Deadline for Early Registration (costs more to apply after this deadline)
- Interviews

December

- Interviews

January

- Interviews
- Rank order list entry begins

February

- Deadline for Rank list certification

March

- Match Day
