Our program's mission is to educate physicians with the knowledge, clinical skills, and attitude to provide excellent care in the field of emergency medicine. It is our purpose to excel in clinical care, education, and scholarship while maintaining an inclusive and supportive environment that encourages a lifetime of learning. Our dynamic curriculum, based at NYU Langone Hospital—Long Island, enables our residents to gain experience treating a diverse, high-acuity patient population with access to the advanced tertiary care expertise of a world-renowned health system. With our own ambulance service and faculty experts in emergency medical services, our prehospital medicine and disaster medicine experiences are a highlight of our program. We are committed to creating a supportive, welcoming, and inclusive program that brings out the best in our residents and faculty.

- We are an Acute, Tertiary/Quaternary Care Hospital

- We treat more than 87,000 patients every year
- Pediatric Emergency Department is housed within the main ED
- We engage learners at all levels in our state of the art Simulation Center
- We are a 3-year EM residency program; recruiting 6 residents per year
- Salary: Starting at **\$84,300** for PGY1s; **\$85,800** for PGY2s and **\$91,800** for PGY3s
- We offer a \$600 allowance per academic year for qualified expenses (books, etc.)
- We offer a one time \$1500 conference stipend for use during the 3-years of the program
- We have housing (assigned via a lottery system) with PGY1s & PGY2s receiving priority
- We offer 4 weeks (20 days) vacation & 2 wellness days per academic year
- In addition to the GME policy, we offer accommodations for new and expecting parents (including birth of a child, adoption of a child, and initiation of foster care for a child)
- Commuter rail station adjacent to campus links us to NYC, JFK airport, UBS Arena, & more
- Free parking for residents and students
