Duties and Responsibilities of each member of the Board:

to serve in the best interest of the entire membership

- attend all regular and special meetings of the Board of Directors
- develop New York ACEP goals and determine future direction

- establish, approve and determine the priority of existing and future programs
- review the relevancy and validity of current programs and services on an annual basis
- support and defend all policies and programs adopted by the Board of Directors
- disseminate information concerning ACEP activities, programs and policies in order to promote a better understanding of New York ACEP services to the individual member, the government, the public, etc.
- obtain all information necessary to consider and vote intelligently on New York ACEP issues
- assist the President in providing clear direction to New York ACEP committees
