SJRH- PARKCARE

ParkCare pavilion is part of the St. John's Riverside 3 campus hospital system. It is a busy behavioral health and addiction medicine treatment center with both inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation and detox facilities. The Emergency Department evaluates a large volume of patients affiliated with ParkCare, who suffer from various substance use disorders, and often present requiring treatment for various overdose and withdrawal syndromes.







PATIENT POPULATION

Our patient population is very diverse, especially in terms of age. Our main campus is in close proximity to a large number of skilled nursing facilities, bringing in patients with a high number of comorbidities. St. John's also offers 24-hour pediatric emergency care. Pediatrics accounts for 17% of our volume.

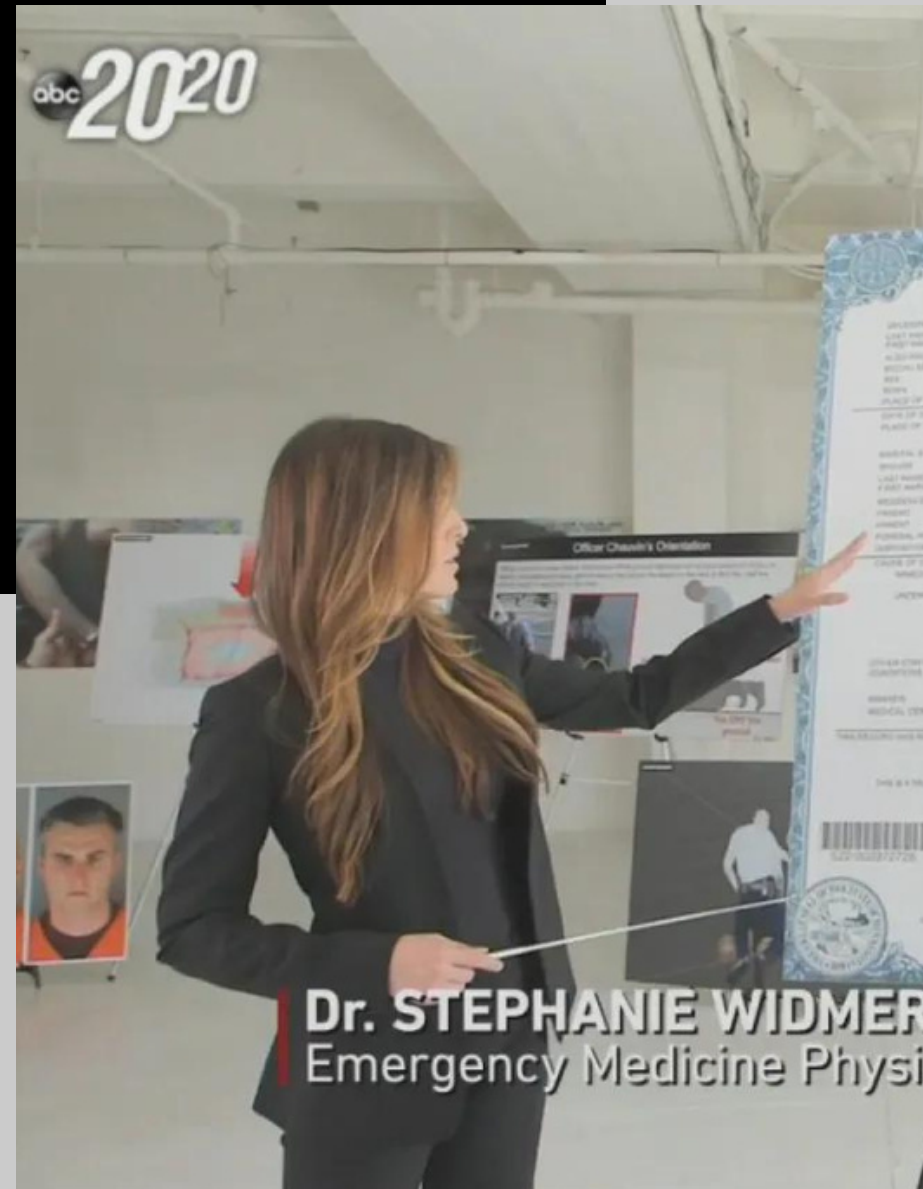


SUBSPECIALTY EXPOSURE
